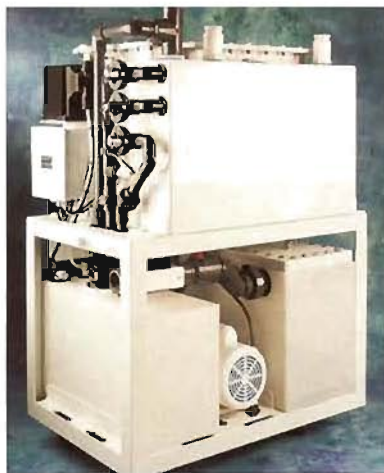

## STABILITY AT SEA
